

Guidelines for Authors of extended Abstracts

All speakers and all presenters of posters at the 9th European Pollen Symposium in Berlin are invited to submit an extended abstract of their lecture/poster until

16 September 2013

All accepted abstracts will be published in issue 8/2013 of Allergo Journal.

Submission

Extended Abstracts can only be submitted as digital files. Files must be sent as e-mail attachment to

christiane.kehl@charite.de

File Format

Text must be saved in Rich Text Format (*.rtf) or Word (*.doc).

Size of abstract

Submitted abstracts must not exceed 5,000 characters (including spaces), may include a maximum of 2 display items (Figures or tables) and a maximum of 4 references.

Structure

Extended abstracts have to be structured as follows:

1. Headline
2. First and last names of all authors
3. Affiliation, City, State of all authors
4. Textbody must be structured into the following sections: background; objective of the study; methods; results; conclusions
5. Name and address of the corresponding author.

Language

Abstracts can be submitted either in English or in German language.

Spelling

Either American or British English spelling can be applied, as long as it is done consistently throughout manuscript. The „new German spelling“ applies for manuscripts written in German.
